ORDER:-

In the Government Order second read above, a panel of 20 Superintending Engineers (2 Nos. for the post of Chief Engineer and 18 Nos. for the post of Special Chief Engineer) fit for temporary promotion as Chief Engineers in Highways Department for the year 2016-2017 has been approved. According to the orders issued in Government Order first read above, an officer should have not less than one year of minimum period of service before retirement to become eligible for promotion as Head of Department and those who do not have minimum service of one year period before retirement shall be compensated by appointing them as Special Chief Engineer with a specific assignment and with the same scale of pay as that of Head of Department.

2. Under Section 47(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, following Superintending Engineers are temporarily promoted as Chief Engineer in Category I of Tamil Nadu Highways Engineering Service on temporary basis with effect from the date of taking charge.

3. The following transfer and postings are ordered with immediate effect:-

4. On temporary promotion of the officers indicated in Para 2 above, the following postings are ordered with effect from the date of taking charge.

- (i) Thiru.A.K.Rajaduraivelpandian, Superintending Engineer (National Highways), Salem is promoted as Chief Engineer and posted as Chief Engineer (H), Projects .
- (ii) Thiru R.Gothandaraman, Superintending Engineer, National Highways Circle, Chennai is promoted as Chief Engineer and posted as Chief Engineer (H), Metro.

The appointments made in para 2 above are purely temporary and are liable to be reverted at any time without prior notice and is subject to implementation of the orders of the Courts in various Writ Petitions and subject to the revision of seniority in the cadre of Assistant Divisional Engineer based on the outcome of court cases pending in this regard.

It is certified as prescribed in Government letter No.8119/FR.1/1980, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 30.4.1980 that the Superintending Engineers who were promoted as Chief Engineer as mentioned in paragraph 2 above satisfy all the rules relating to regular appointment to the post to which they have been temporarily promoted so as to enable them to get their initial pay fixed in the scale of pay as applicable to the post of Chief Engineer.
